Abstract

Coordination between international police agencies is the cornerstone to combating cybercrime, a global threat. Public press releases do not accurately reflect all the background work needed for a successful takedown of a criminal enterprise. Hear a detailed account of the work done by the RCMP during the 2021 global takedown of the botnet EMOTET.
